

Public Hearing- Town of Newfield  
May 11, 2017

The Town of Newfield convened a Public Hearing on May 11, 2017 at the Newfield Town Hall, 166 Main Street, Newfield New York. Supervisor Hart called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 pm and stated the purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear public comment on the proposed Local Law No. 4 of 2017: A Local Law to encourage appropriate and beneficial development of solar farms and to encourage the preservation of natural features, topography, and resources; and to generally protect the health, safety and public welfare of the residents of the town.

Present were: Supervisor Jeff Hart, Councilperson Christine Laughlin, Councilperson Casey Powers and 18 attendees. Councilpersons Joanne James and Mike Allinger were absent.
