The Newfield Town Board convened a Public Hearing on July 14, 2016 at the Newfield Town Hall, 166 Main Street, Newfield NY. Supervisor Hart called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m. and stated the purpose of the Public Hearing was to obtain public comment on proposed Local Law No. 4 of 2016: A Local Law to promote the effective and efficient use of the Town's wind energy resources through Wind Energy Facilities and Wind Turbine Generators.

Present were: Supervisor Hart, Councilperson James, Councilperson Laughlin, Councilperson Powers and Councilperson Allinger. Also present Attorney Seth Hiland and 21 attendees.

Privilege of the Floor

Jude Lemke: a Town of Enfield resident stated her comments were hers and Marcus Gingerich(also an Enfield resident). Ms. Lemke commented regarding the noise, suggesting clarification for noise and setback limits.

Kristen Wells: a Newfield resident thanked the Board for addressing concerns and the setback limits for the Town of Newfield. Ms. Wells commented she had concerns regarding noise decibel levels of 52. She felt it was high for the property line especially if there is a residence there.

Jeffner Allen: a Newfield resident thanked the Board for the time spent regarding the proposed local law.

At 7:10 p.m., a motion was made by Councilperson James to close the Public Hearing as there being no other public comment regarding the proposed moratorium, seconded by Councilperson Allinger.
