The Newfield Town Board convened a Public Hearing on October 8, 2015 at the Newfield Fire Hall, 77 Main Street, Newfield NY. Supervisor Hart called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. and stated the purpose of the Public Hearing was to obtain public comment on proposed Local Law No. 3 of the Town of Newfield for the year 2015 which would be known as the as Town of Newfield Noise Law which, if adopted, will regulate and prohibit certain unreasonable and excessive noise within the Town. Present were: Supervisor Hart, Councilperson Trask, Councilperson James, Councilperson Laughlin and Councilperson Powers.

Privilege of the Floor:

*Gary C. Allen:* current owner of the Sebring Inn commented he was displeased with proposed Local Law No. 3-2015 and did not support it.

*Shawn Brown:* supports proposed Local Law No. 3-2015.

*Maria Lloyd Jones:* questioned why Newfield needs a noise law. Ms. Lloyd Jones does not support proposed Local Law No. 3-2015.

*Dr. Cheryl Thomas:* stated that she does not support proposed Local Law No 3-2015 as written.

*Diana Bryant:* questioned the proposed law as presented. She felt as presented it is subjective and needs revisions.

*Brenda Lapp:* supported proposed Local Law No. 3-2015 and complimented the Board on its preparation.

*Marc Redman:* asked for further definition of unnecessary or unusual noise.

*Bob Mente:* felt some of the noise concerns needed to be identified where property owners could be within their legal rights and limits.

Being no other comments concerning proposed Local Law No 3 of 2015 Town of Newfield Noise Law, Supervisor Hart declared the Public Hearing closed at 7:18 p.m.
