Meeting called to Order at 7:02 PM by Chair; Karen Trask

Privilege of the Floor: No Comment

Randy Brown requested to move approval of Meeting Minutes from June 6, 2018 meeting until the next meeting.

This evenings meeting was a collaboration between the Planning Board and the Town Board.

Planning Board presented the Dog, Animal and Noise Ordinances to the Town Board and expressed eagerness to see that after ordinances become law that they will be enforced.

- Randy Brown suggested that procedures and fines be set up along with the proposed laws to give a fair guide to the judicial system instead of deciding case by case.
- Joanne James requested more time to read the Ordinances over.
- A first draft of the Awareness and Complaint Document was reviewed and changes were documented.
- Christine Laughlin was looking into ways that we could get these Ordinances once they become Law out to the Community.
- Timeline for the Ordinances are set as; Discuss at July work meeting, Introduce to the Public at the August meeting, and a Public Hearing in September. (All dates subject to change)

Updates on the Delaware River Solar Project on the corner of Millard Hill Road and Burdge Hill Road.

- The group researched the Site Plan Law and concluded that a SPR is needed for that property and that Karen Trask would Email DRS to set up a meeting to discuss that process up.

Randy Brown brought up Employing teens, and how Newfield really has no way to compensate these teens as a town. This is something they will look into with Town budget and attempt to employ youth in the future.
